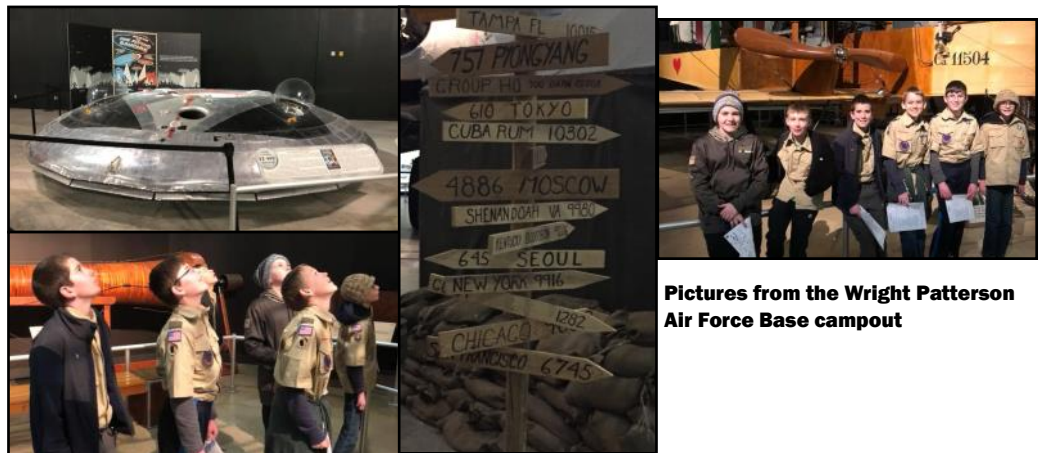
WPAFB Campout Summary

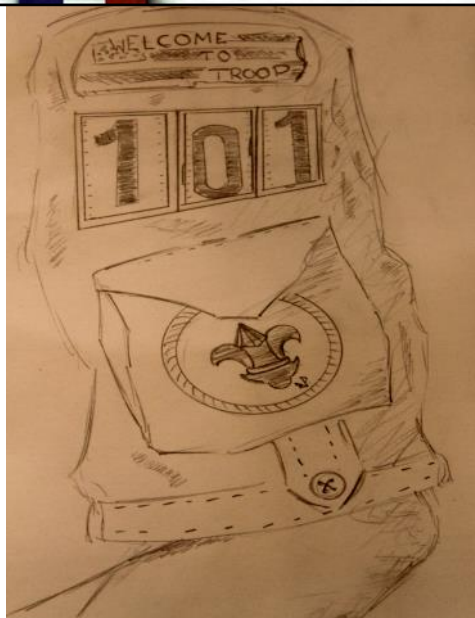

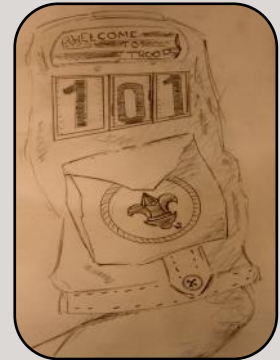
