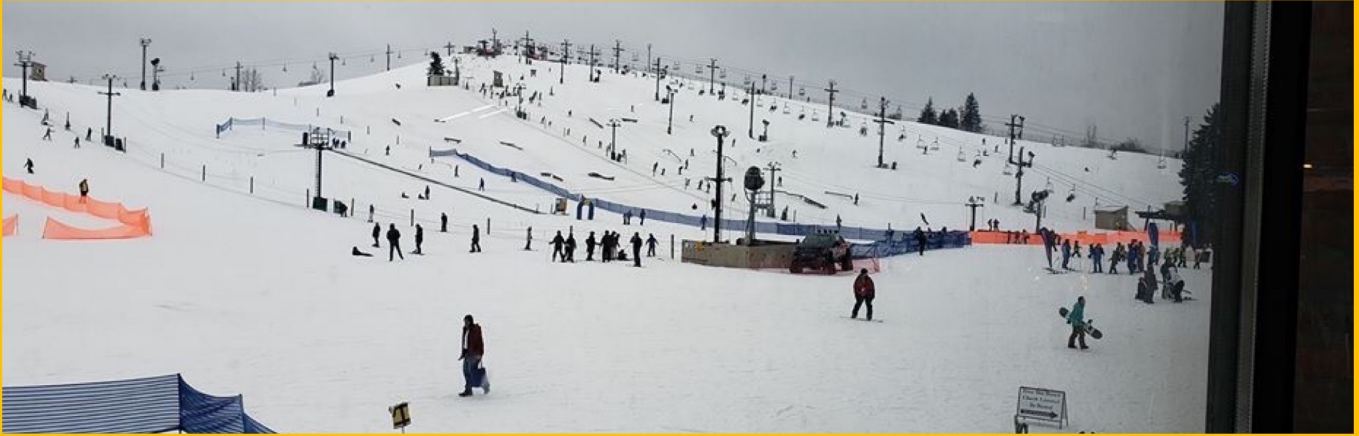
Pokagon Toboggan and Campout @ Pokagon State Park December 13-15, 2019
